### VERSE 3


In Christ alone we're justified;

Now by Your pow'r have been made new.



### A Study of Daniel 10



Daniel 10 - 12 : Be ready to be shown the truth -

- by observing God at work,
- by practicing meaningful prayer,
- by meditating on God's word.

### INTRODUCTION

1. Daniel 9:24-27 – Daniel's "70 weeks"
2. The last 3 chapters of Daniel are one unit:
  - a. Chapter 10 – Welcome to fasting, prayer, and angelic visitors
  - b. Chapter 11 – Another shocking revelation of God's providence
  - c. Chapter 12 – Encouragement to be faithful as God's mystery unfolds

## CHAPTER TEN

### 1. Vs. 1 – Prologue

- a. Vs. 1a – God works in time
- b. Vs. 1b – God knows our name
- c. Vs. 1c – God communicates with His servants — Daniel's 4th vision
  - (1.) Is revealed by God
  - (2.) Is true
  - (3.) Contains great conflict
  - (4.) Understood by Daniel

Daniel's narrative now changes from 3<sup>rd</sup> person to 1<sup>st</sup> person.

### 2. Vv. 2 - 4 – A Spiritually Focused Time

- a. Vv. 2-3 – Mourning
- b. Vs. 4
  - (1.) Personal Reflection – “First month” was time of the Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread
  - (2.) Worship of God for His Work in Israel’s History
- c. Application – 3 Questions
  - (1.) How deeply do you allow your soul to mourn before God over the affairs of your life?
  - (2.) What motivates you to pray?
  - (3.) How do you reflect on God’s blessings in your life?

### 3. Vv. 5 - 21 – An Angelic Visitation

- a. Vv. 5 - 6 – Description of the One Sent
  - (1.) “Behold” used 4x in Ch. 10, 20x in full book of Daniel; always during Daniel’s visions
  - (2.) Angelic garments represent:
    - (a.) royalty
    - (b.) authority
    - (c.) multiplicity
- b. Vv. 7 - 9 – Response of Daniel
  - Application – 1 Peter 5:6, James 4:10
- c. Vv. 10 - 14 – Declaration of the One Sent
  - (1.) Comfort offered
  - (2.) Effectual prayer honored
  - (3.) Delay explained
  - (4.) Message proclaimed
- d. Vv. 15 - 17 – Daniel’s Desperation
  - (1.) Description
  - (2.) Daniel’s Question
- e. Vv. 18 - 21 – Angelic Affirmation
