### VERSE 2

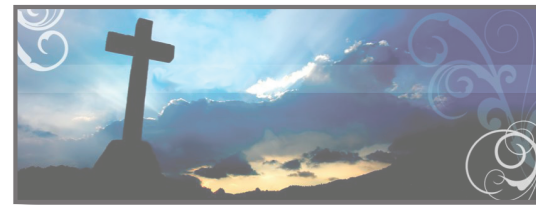
I was blinded by my sin, had no ears to hear Your voice,
