THE FAMILY

Ephesians 5:1-4

Considering the Family

- » Family is the first institution created by God – Genesis 1:28
- » Children are a gift from the LORD – Psalm 127:3, 139:13
- » God has given a proper arrangement to the family – Ephesians 5:18b, 21; 1 Corinthians 11:1-3

WHAT DOES THE BIBLICAL FAMILY LOOK LIKE?

1. Children Are Given the Responsibility of Obedience (6:1)
 - a. Definition : “under hearing”
 - b. Direction : “in the LORD”
 - c. Determination : “for this is right”
2. Children Are Given a Command with Promise (6:2-3)
 - a. The Command – Exodus 20:12, Genesis 18:18-19
 - b. The Promise
3. Children Are Given Protection from Emotional and Circumstantial Abuse, and Given the Help to Obey (6:4)
 - a. A Father’s Responsibility – Colossians 3:21
 - b. The Process of Parenting
