BEHOLD MY SERVANT, PT. 2

Isaiah 42:10-25

The Response to Beholding God’s Servant Is —

1. Worship (vv 10-12)

- a. Expressed in a “new song” (v 10)
- b. Expressed by all inhabitants (v 11)
- c. Expressed to the LORD for His worth (v 12)

2. Witnessing the War-Like Spirit of the Lord (vv 13-17)

- a. Supreme Warrior, Creator of every earthly conqueror (v 13)
- b. His patience ends (v 14)
