FIRST AND FOREMOST: JESUS CHRIST

A MINISTER'S CHOICES IN PROCLAIMING CHRIST

Colossians 1:24 - 2:5

While in prison in Rome, Paul chose —

- 1. To Suffer in Joy for Colossian Believers Colossians 1:24a
 - a. Following the teaching of Jesus Christ John 15:20
 - b. Following the example of New Testament leaders Acts 5:41
 - c. Following the Spirit of Jesus Christ Hebrews 12:1-2
- 2. To Fill Up What Is Lacking Colossians 1:24b
 - a. God decrees believers will suffer Philippians 1:29-30
 - b. For the Sake of the Church 1 Corinthians 12:12
 - (1.) because the lie of Satan is always hostile to truth 2 Corinthians 11:3, 14-15
 - (2.) because darkness is always hostile to the light John 1:4-5
 - (3.) because evil deeds are always hostile to holiness Colossians 1:21
 - (4.) because the natural bent for born-again believers is truth, light, and holiness Revelation 6:9-11

- 3. To Fulfill God's Assignment for Him
 - a. The Job Description Colossians 1:25a
 - (1.) Minister *diakonos* = "to kick up dust," as one running an errand; a servant
 - (2.) Stewardship *oikonomia* = looking after another's affairs; management; administration
 - b. The Job Source Colossians 1:25b
 - c. The Job Responsibility Colossians 1:25c-29
- 4. To Struggle for Their Spiritual Encouragement, Order, and Firm Faith Colossians 2:1-5
