**KINGLY INTERRUPTIONS AND DISRUPTIONS**

Luke 19:28-44

1. The Gospel accounts explain how Jesus defined His kingship.
2. Palm Sunday shows us how Jesus declared His kingship.
  - a. Jesus proclaimed His kingship to Jerusalem by interrupting Passover preparations through a public procession. — Matthew 23:37
  - b. Jesus sometimes brings us to Palm Sunday moments by "riding into" an area of our lives that needs to be brought under His kingship.

When this happens we should keep three things in mind:

- (1.) Jesus IS our King.
- (2.) His disruptions can feel inconvenient, even disruptive.
- (3.) His kingship is a blessing, not a burden.
