What Transhumanists Believe

- 1. Man has evolved from nothing
- 2. The world and humanity face many problems
- 3. Salvation from the problems of the world come through technology
- 4. Through human advancement, humans can reach a perfection for eternity

The Gospel According to the Word of God

- 1. Creation—God created a perfect world with perfect creatures to commune with Him: Genesis 1-2, Jeremiah 32:17, Revelation 4:11
- 2. Fall—Man sinned and because of sin, man is under the judgment of God
 - a. Romans 3:23, 5:12, 6:23
 - b. Fourfold Death
 - i. Judicial Death—found guilty
 - ii. Spiritual Death—separated from God
 - iii. Physical Death—bodily decay and eventual demise
 - iv. Eternal Death—torment of an eternity away from God and His grace
- 3. Redemption—Jesus reconciled fallen man to the Holy God through His death on the cross: John 3:16-17, Ephesians 1:7
- 4. Restoration—Jesus' righteousness is imputed to those who believe restoring them to God for eternity: Romans 5:1, 10:9-13, 8:33-39

The Gospel (Salvation Message) According to Transhumanism

- 1. Creation—There is no creator; humans are self-creators
- 2. Fall—There is no sin, only bad things in the earth, and usually humans are the cause of the problems
- 3. Redemption—No redemption because there is no sin; humans can evolve to fix the problems they have caused
- 4. Restoration—The problem of death can be solved by technology

Humanity at the Center of Our Own Salvation

- 1. *Gene Editing*: "A method that lets scientists change the DNA of many organisms including plants, bacteria, and animals. Editing DNA can lead to changes in physical traits, like eye color, and disease risk."—National Human Genome Research Institute
- 2. *Synthetic Biology*: "A field of science that involves redesigning organisms for useful purposes by engineering them to have new abilities."—National Human Genome Research Institute
- 3. Artificial Intelligence (AI): "Computer systems that can perform complex tasks normally done by human-reasoning, decision making, creating, etc."—NASA
- 4. *Brain-Computer Interfaces (BCI)*: "System that determines functional intent—the desire to change, move, control, or interact with something in your environment from brain activity." Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary.
