Jesus tells His followers to expect Kingdom entrance to be —

1. DIFFICULT — Mark 10:23-25
 - a. The Rich Young Ruler
 - b. The Wealthy
 - c. A Sense of Despair
 - d. Salvation Is a Gift from God Alone
2. APPLICATION How do we apply this to our lives in 2026? — Mark 10:25-27
